Background of the Program

Established in 2048 B.S. (1992) and located in Sundarharaincha-12, Morang, Sukuna Multiple Campus (SMC) is a community-based public educational institution. It offers BA, BBA, B.Ed., BICTE, B.Sc., B.Ed., BBS, MBS, and M.Ed. programs with affiliation from Tribhuvan University.

SMC aims at providing higher education at an affordable cost with all and special privileges for the promising students. It was accredited by the University Grants Commission (UGC), Nepal, in 2015 AD and is in the second cycle of its accreditation. As a leading campus in the eastern part of Nepal, it is growing physically, academically, and professionally by sharing its ideas, knowledge, and information with different institutions at the national and international levels. It has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Assam Down Town University (ADTU), India, and the University of Information Technology and Science (UITS), Bangladesh.

A faculty exchange program typically involves academic institutions partnering to facilitate the temporary exchange of professors or teaching staff between them. Such programs aim to promote collaboration, cultural exchange, and professional development among faculty members from different institutions and often different countries. Following the tempo, as per the agreement of the Faculty Exchange Program between ADTU and SMC, a seven-day guest lecture and interaction has been conducted with the facilitation of Associate Professor Dr. Bishal Bhuyan from ADTU.

Objective of the Program

The primary aim of the faculty exchange program was to provide the opportunity for the exchanged workforces to encourage professional development through the stimulus of a different setting and for the host organizations to benefit from the knowledge and skills of the exchanged workforces. The specific objectives of the program were as follows:

- to enhance academic collaboration between faculty members from ADTU and SMC.
- to expose faculty members and students to different teaching methods, research approaches, and academic environments.
- to exchange ideas, best practices, and expertise between faculty members

Dr. Bhuyan arrived in Nepal on March 12. The Department of National and International Affairs received and welcomed him from the Nepal-India border. They sat together to finalize the plan for the lectures, talks, and presentations.

The guest lecture began on March 13, 2024, at Sukuna Multiple Campus, Sundarharaicha 12 Morang, in the gracious presence of Dr. Bhuyan on behalf of the exchange program. As per it, Dr. Bhuyan shared his valuable insights and contents on marketing management with the students of MBS first semester. As an institutional facilitator and subject expert at the given university from India, Dr. Bhuyan employed the discussion, experience sharing, and lecture methods in sharing the content. The students from MBS 1st semester were facilitated with the sharing in a productive way. On the very day, he delivered his guest lecture on the contents of

the course “Fundamentals of Marketing” to the students of BBA 4th semester on the topic of “Product and Promotion.” The students from SMC were pleased to listen to the facilitator through lecture, discussion, and experience sharing. Similarly, RMC held the meeting with Dr. Bhuyan in the evening to discuss research practices, journal publication, research, publication, and evaluation processes of the faculty, the support system of ADTU for research and publication, implementation practices of research for teaching and learning, the importance of research and publication, research collaboration methods and practices, practices of research, article writing, and publication, and experience sharing.

The exchange program continued for the next day too, exchanging experiences, lectures, and discussions with the faculty, Dr. Bhuyan from the University of India. The classes facilitated in this regard were MBS 1st semester, BBS, and BBA 3rd semester from SMC. The exchange cum discussion program continued with further sharing within the BBS class, with facilitation for the students from the visiting faculty, Dr. Bhuyan from ADTU and Mr. Trilochan Sitaula, Assistant Lecturer from SMC, on the topic of sensitization of entrepreneurship. The sharing sought to develop and motivate a positive mindset among the students regarding entrepreneurship. He widely informed the students about the types of entrepreneurs like drone entrepreneurs, Fabian entrepreneurs, imitation entrepreneurs, and innovative entrepreneurs. Along with his knowledge of entrepreneurship, he also talked about the strategies of 'marketing startups.' The facilitators also talked about the strategies of research and academic writing. The conduct also discussed the mandatory publishing of articles by the teaching faculties at the university. The facilitators employed PowerPoint presentations, lecture methods, and discussion in sharing the session. Also, it ensured to liberate the students from a job-seeking mindset to create individual enterprises for themselves. The discussion and sharing ensured prominent financial and individual skills like leadership skills like commitment, time management, and organizational and individual financial stability. Students were well content with the delivery of the lecture from Dr. Bhuyan and the facilitator from the campus.

The exchange program continued on March 15, when the facilitator, Dr. Bhuyan shared his ideas at SMC. Dr. Bhuyan, as a facilitator, talked with the students of the BBA 1st semester on the Fundamentals of Business Management. The students from SMC were happy to listen to

his lecture, experiences, and narratives. Students made some queries about different subject matters.

Perhaps March 16 must have been memorable for him, for SMC organized sightseeing and a night stay in a beautiful area of Vedetar-Namje, one of the popular tourist destinations in Eastern Nepal.

The faculty exchange on Day 6 marked the sharing of knowledge from Dr. Bhuyan with the faculty members of the department of management in the campus meeting hall. In the meeting, Dr. Bhuyan spoke on research sharing at the personal and institutional level. Many of the queries from the faculty members of SMC were addressed by Dr. Bhuyan. He also acknowledged the facilities and convenience offered by the campus administration during his stay at SMC. He also delivered and discussed research and its importance with the students of the BBA 8th semester.

The faculty exchange program reached its conclusion when the College Management Committee (CMC), under the presidency of Mr. Keshab Adhikari, thanked and congratulated the facilitator, Dr. Bhuyan, for his positive and fruitful visit and conduct during his stay at SMC. Also, the president put an emphasis on the continuation of similar visits and exchanges in the days to come.

Methodology of the Program/Process

As per the MOU, SMC sent a letter of invitation to ADTU via email, asking for the expert to deliver the guest lectures. As per the request, ADTU sent Dr. Bhuyan for the very purpose. The program mainly focused on guest lectures and sharing experiences. Employing different methodologies like presentation, discussion, experience sharing, lecture method, reflection, and Q & A, the exchange program lasted for seven days. All the activities were recorded in texts and photos were taken as evidence.

Achievement/Outcomes from the Program

The exchange program between ADTU and SMC created a scholastic instance for bilateral relations between the two holistic institutions. The conduct was a high success in the sense that it set an academic and speculative example to offer further expansion of newness in

knowledge. Also, the program emphasizes strategic alliances in acquiring common goals in the given faculties. The major outcomes of the program are as follows:

- It enhanced academic collaboration and professional networking between ADTU and SMC.
- Faculty members and students were exposed to different teaching methods, research and publication, subject-related contents, and academic environments.
- SMC became more informed about some of the of the best practices of ADTU.
- Students were more motivated to be taught by the guest speaker. They gained some insights, knowledge, and skills.
- It helped the campus envision its future plans in the field of research and publications.
- The program enhanced the reputation, visibility, and credibility of the campus.

Conclusion

A seven-day faculty exchange program that began on March 12th lasted until March 18th, 2024. Besides delivering guest lectures to the students of BBA, BBS, and MBS at SMC, Dr. Bhuyan also shared how research, publication, and participation in conferences and seminars are important in every institution and one's professional career. Such program helps the campus meet the vision, mission, goals, and objectives of the campus and envision its future plans in the fields of faculty development programs, research, and publication and implement the best practices. The campus has realized that such programs are impactful for academic and institutional development. It helps faculty members gain valuable insights, expand their professional networks, and contribute to the internationalization of the campus. It also helps foster academic excellence and global engagement. However, if the best practices shared by Dr. Bhuyan in teaching, management, research, publication, and faculty development are not implemented in practice, organizing such programs will be meaningless.

Recommendations

The faculty exchange program that was conducted for seven days was expected to be very fruitful for the campus. Therefore, it is necessary to conduct such exchange programs more frequently between ADTU and SMC in the days ahead to strengthen the institutional

collaboration. However, the following suggestions are recommended to make such programs more fruitful:

- The needs of the faculty and students need to be properly analyzed.
- Clear objectives should be set beforehand.
- Comprehensive plans should be made.
- The guest speakers need to be informed about the areas/needs beforehand.
- The program's effectiveness should be evaluated through feedback mechanisms and outcome assessments.
