Introduction of Program

Sukuna Multiple Campus is a community-based public campus affiliated with Tribhuvan University. The campus runs the programs of Humanities and Social Sciences, Education, Management, and Science faculties at the Bachelor's level and the Master's level (postgraduate level). Classes are run in the faculties of Education and the Faculty of Management. M.Ed. program started in B.S. 2061 and MBs in B.S. 2063. It aims at providing Higher Education at an affordable means with all and special privileges for promising students. Under the Faculty of Education, students can choose from seven specialized subject areas. The selection of the specialization subjects is exclusively based on the criteria set by the affiliating university (TU). In both postgraduate programs, students must submit a complete thesis in the final year.

Background of Program

A comprehensive three-day workshop titled "Strengthening Master's Level Thesis Supervision Workshop" was successfully conducted at Sukuna Multiple Campus from Baisakh 8-10, 2082. The program was designed to enhance the capabilities of faculty members in effectively supervising master's level theses. The workshop featured a diverse range of sessions covering theoretical foundations, practical supervision techniques, and ethical considerations delivered by experienced academic professionals.

Objective

The Objectives of this training module are:

a. To update the roles and responsibilities of a thesis supervisor

b. To prepare supervisors with effective mentoring and communication strategies

- c. To address common challenges in thesis supervision
- d. To communicate the recent trends in thesis writing.
- e. To develop a supportive supervisory guideline that fosters student independence.

Methodology

The following methods will be used interchangeably as per the necessity of the subject matter

- a. Workshops: Interactive sessions group and pair activities
- b. Case Studies: Analysis of real-life supervision scenarios and discussing the solutions
- c. Feedback Sessions: opportunities for participants to discuss their experiences and challenges. d. Mentorship Circles: Small group discussions for peer support and sharing experiences. Participant selection

As mentioned in the proposal, we included all the teaching faculties and also invited the participants from 7 neighboring public campuses. whose details are given below:

Day One (2082/02/08)

Opening Session (9:30-10:30 AM)

The workshop commenced with a refreshment period followed by formal registration and inauguration procedures organized by the Training Unit. The inaugural session included welcome remarks, introduction of participants and resource persons, and an overview of workshop objectives. This session established the context for the workshop, highlighting the importance of effective thesis supervision in maintaining academic standards and fostering research excellence.

Basics of Thesis Supervision (10:30 AM-12:00 PM)

Mrs. Ushakiran Wagle facilitated a comprehensive 90-minute session on the fundamental principles of effective thesis supervision. The session covered key supervisory responsibilities, establishing productive supervisor-student relationships, and understanding the institutional requirements for master's level theses. Participants gained insights into supervision models, communication strategies, and techniques for guiding students through the research journey. The session emphasized the supervisor's role as both academic mentor and research facilitator. The session also discovered the problems faced by supervisors throughout the supervising journey.

Student Psychology in Thesis Writing (1:00-2:30 PM)

Following the lunch break, Mr. Shankar Dewan conducted an informative session focusing on psychological aspects of student experiences during thesis writing. This 90-minute workshop addressed common psychological challenges faced by graduate students, including anxiety, writer's block, perfectionism, and motivational issues. Participants learned effective strategies for recognizing distress signals, providing appropriate emotional support,

Reviewing Literature (2:35-4:05 PM)

Dr. Suresh Gautam led an in-depth session on guiding students through literature review processes. This 90-minute workshop covered methodologies for comprehensive literature searches, critical evaluation of scholarly sources, and synthesis of existing knowledge. Participants learned techniques for helping students identify research gaps, establish theoretical foundations, and position their work within existing scholarly conversations. The session provided practical guidance on helping students overcome common literature review challenges and develop academic writing skills.

Conceptual and Theoretical Frameworks (4:10-5:40 PM)

Dr. Suresh Gautam continued with an advanced 90-minute session on developing robust conceptual and theoretical frameworks for master's theses. This workshop explored the differences between conceptual and theoretical frameworks, their interconnections, and their critical role in guiding research design. Participants gained skills in helping students articulate appropriate frameworks that align with research questions and methodological approaches. The session included practical exercises for evaluating framework quality and

providing guidance for framework refinement.

Day Two (2082/02/09

Abstract Management (10:00-11:30 AM)

Following morning refreshments, Dr. Suresh Gautam facilitated a specialized 90minute session on abstract development and refinement. This workshop addressed the critical components of effective research abstracts, common pitfalls in abstract writing, and techniques for achieving clarity and precision. Participants learned strategies for guiding students in crafting abstracts that effectively communicate research purpose, methodology, findings, and significance. The session emphasized the strategic importance of abstracts in research dissemination and academic publishing.

Constructive Feedback Techniques (12:30-2:00 PM)

After lunch, Dr. Suresh Gautam conducted a practical 90-minute workshop on providing effective feedback to thesis students. This session explored different feedback modalities, timing considerations, and approaches for balancing critique with encouragement. Participants developed skills in delivering specific, actionable, and growth-oriented feedback across various thesis components. The workshop emphasized feedback as a developmental tool and included role-playing exercises to practice difficult feedback scenarios.

Editing and Proofreading (2:00-3:30 PM)

Mr. Basudev Dahal led a technical session focusing on editorial guidance for thesis supervision. This workshop covered different levels of editing, common language issues in academic writing, and strategies for improving document coherence. Participants learned techniques for helping students enhance clarity, precision, and scholarly tone in their writing. The session distinguished between the supervisor's editorial role and the student's

responsibility for final manuscript quality.

Citation and Referencing (3:30-4:45 PM)

Ganesh Prasad Dahal and Nara Prasad Bhandari jointly facilitated a 75-minute workshop on citation systems and reference management. This session provided comprehensive guidance on APA 7th edition citation standards, common referencing errors, and techniques for maintaining citation consistency. Participants learned strategies for

helping students organize reference materials effectively and avoid academic integrity issues.

The workshop included hands-on practice with reference management tools and

troubleshooting complex citation scenarios.

Day Three (2082/02/10)

Ethical Considerations (7:30-9:00 AM)

Following early morning refreshments, Dr. Suresh Gautam conducted a session on ethical dimensions of thesis supervision. This workshop addressed research ethics approval processes, data integrity issues, plagiarism prevention, and ethical dilemmas in supervisor-student relationships. Participants gained insights into balancing supervisory authority with student autonomy and managing conflicts of interest. The session emphasized the supervisor's responsibility in cultivating ethical research practices and academic integrity.

Thesis Supervision Process (9:00-10:30 AM)

Dr. Suresh Gautam continued with an extended 150-minute comprehensive workshop on the complete thesis supervision process. This in-depth session covered the entire supervision journey from initial proposal development to final thesis defense. Participants learned practical strategies for establishing timelines, conducting progress meetings, managing revisions, and preparing students for defense presentations. The workshop addressed common supervision challenges and provided structured approaches for different thesis development stages.

Active Listening and Empathy (10:30-12:00 PM)

After lunch, Dr. Mohan Kumar Tumbahang facilitated a 90-minute workshop focused on interpersonal dimensions of supervision. This session explored active listening techniques, empathy development, and communication strategies for building productive supervisory relationships. Participants learned approaches for recognizing students' unspoken concerns,

responding to emotional cues, and creating supportive academic environments. The workshop emphasized the connection between empathetic supervision and student research success.

APA 7th Edition and Report Structuring (1:30-3:00 PM)

Finally, Matrika Thapa conducted a technical session on thesis formatting and structural requirements. This workshop provided comprehensive guidance on APA 7th edition formatting standards, document structure, and physical presentation requirements. Participants gained skills in guiding students through technical aspects of thesis preparation including pagination, headings, table formatting, and binding specifications. The session emphasized the importance of professional presentation in academic credibility.

Closing Ceremony (3:00-3:30 PM)

The workshop concluded with a formal 30-minute closing ceremony organized by the Training Unit. The closing session was conducted by Maya Dewan a member of Training Unit. This final session included certificate distribution to participants, collection of feedback on workshop effectiveness, and closing remarks from institutional representatives. The ceremony acknowledged participants' commitment to supervision excellence and encouraged implementation of learned techniques. The session provided closure to the intensive three-day professional development program.

Some of the key takeaways of this three day long workshop are:

Supervisors must balance academic guidance with emotional intelligence.

- Providing timely and constructive feedback is essential.
- Understanding the APA 7th edition format is critical for guiding students.
- Ethical supervision requires both procedural knowledge and moral sensitivity.
- Technology tools (e.g., citation managers) can greatly assist in maintaining accuracy.

Future perspective and challenges

The workshop on Strengthening Master's Level Thesis Supervision's future perspectives and challenges are given below:

Future perspectives

- a) Enhanced the Supervisor's role with effective mentoring skills, ethical supervision practices, and updated research methodologies.
- b) The future of thesis supervision may involve AI-driven research support tools, automated plagiarism detection, and digital mentoring platforms.
- c) Universities might focus on fostering interdisciplinary research collaborations, allowing students and supervisors to work across faculties and institutions.
- d) Institutions may implement universally accepted frameworks for research methodology, plagiarism control, and thesis formatting.
- e) Adopting mentorship models that empower students to take greater ownership of their research journey.

Challenges

- a) Ethical Concerns and the necessity of plagiarism checks will challenge both students and supervisors in maintaining academic integrity.
- b) Increasing student enrollment in graduate programs could lead to supervisors handling multiple theses, making personalized mentorship difficult.
- c) Supervisors must continuously update their knowledge in emerging research methodologies and global academic standards.
- d) Some institutions might struggle with limited funding, impacting the availability of research materials, training programs, and expert guidance.
- e) Encouraging student autonomy in research while ensuring they receive necessary support and constructive feedback.

Conclusion and recommendation

The "Strengthening Master's Level Thesis Supervision Workshop" provided a comprehensive professional development opportunity for academic faculty involved in thesis supervision. Through carefully sequenced sessions covering both technical and interpersonal aspects of supervision, the program equipped participants with enhanced capabilities for guiding master's students through the research process. 
